




Opening



Join us in discovering and experiencing each craft village in Hanoi, and in doing so, gain a deeper understanding of the diversity and richness of Vietnamese culture.



Address: Hong Van Commune, Thường Tín District, Hanoi

Nestled in the heart of Thường Tín District, the Hong Van Artistry Village of Flora, a mere 20 kilometers to the south of Hanoi's bustling center, awaits your arrival. As a riverside region with a rich historical tradition linked to the legend of Chử Đồng Tử - Tiên Dung (one of the Four Immortals in Vietnamese folklore), Hồng Vân boasts a cultural heritage and is renowned for its agricultural products, especially ornamental plant cultivation. In the early 2000s, leveraging the fertile alluvial soil, the people of Hồng Vân vigorously developed the ornamental plant cultivation industry, primarily supplying the inner city areas of Hanoi. Transforming from an agricultural commune, the craft village of Hồng Vân has evolved towards ecotourism, focusing on the cultivation of ornamental plants and combining agriculture with tourism and services.

Moreover, our dear guests can partake in the extraordinary "Day as an Artisan" experience, an opportunity to collaborate with the village's skillful artisans, unleashing your creative spirit as you personally craft, sculpt, mold, and christen your very own botanical masterpieces. 

Bat Trang, the venerable Ceramic Village, nestled in Bat Trang Commune, Gia Lam District, Hanoi, is tracing its roots back over a thousand years, emerging in the 14th and 15th centuries. Within this artisanal enclave, a symphony of fired clay comes to life. Yet, it's the ceramic bricks and pottery, adorned in elegance, that claim fame above all. These bricks, celebrated not just for their meticulous artistry, but also for their exclusive dimensions and colors, set a singular standard, unmatched by any other craft across the land. The distinctive clay composition of Bát Tràng pottery is created from a mixture of sand and silt from the Red River. The pottery is fired at relatively high temperatures ranging from 1250 to 1320 degrees Celsius, resulting in products with high durability and deep, rich enamel colors, embodying the unique characteristics of ancient pottery. Bát Tràng ceramics exhibit colors that are warm and refined, featuring intricate and meticulous hand-drawn patterns that closely connect with the Vietnamese cultural aesthetic.

CHUYÊN MŶ

Lacquerware and Mother-of-pearl inlay

Address: Chuyên Mỹ Commune, Phú Xuyên District, Hanoi

Mother-of-pearl inlay and lacquer artistry, a craft that's hailed as the cradle of Vietnam's artisanal splendor. From the tiniest seashells and minuscule pearls, the skilled artisans of Chuyen My create intricate patterns that defy intricacy and complexity. This craft goes beyond mere carving, grinding, and assembling within predetermined molds; it's a meticulous process that involves numerous stages to produce a complete work of mother-of-pearl inlay and lacquer art. Each seashell possesses its unique allure – the dark, petite wings contrasting with the thick, veined shell, while the nacre inside shimmers, resembling a radiant rainbow. In tandem with seashells, red snail shells, with their luxurious hues, are considered precious materials used to craft picturesque landscapes, phoenix wings, dragon wings, and intricate motifs on the resplendent silk paintings of kings and royalty.

4. Vailoring Patt Village

VÂN TÙ

Address: Vân Từ Commune, Phú Xuyên District, Hanoi

Inheriting and developing the traditional values passed down through generations, the people of Van Tu have journeyed to Hanoi, not only to earn a livelihood but to enrich their homeland and their nation with the art of silk weaving. With a heritage spanning centuries, this place has nurtured countless gifted artisans. Keeping pace with market trends, these artisans don't just stop at honing their skills; many families and small-scale producers have also established successful business models, turning into renowned companies with a strong market presence. The products of Van Tu have reached various provinces, cities across the country, the region, and even the global stage.



5. Townist Alpaction

HẠ THÁI

Lacquer Village

Address: Duyên Thái Commune, Thường Tín District, Hanoi

Legend has it that the craft of lacquerware in Ha Thai dates back to the 17th century when it was primarily an art of embellishing objects. While not the birthplace of Vietnamese lacquer art, Ha Thai was revered for its multitude of highly skilled and creative artisans. In the early 1930s, Vietnam's pioneering artists, who had studied at the Indochina School of Fine Arts, embarked on a quest to explore new materials such as eggshells, shells, and bamboo nodes, and most notably, they introduced a unique lacquer polishing technique that gave birth to authentic lacquer paintings. The terms "lacquerware" and "lacquer paintings" emerged during this period. These lacquer paintings employ traditional lacquer materials like lacquer sap and lacquer varnish as binding agents, along with various pigments, silver foil, gold foil, and seashells, all meticulously applied to a canvas of dark hues.

Address: Hoa Binh Commune, Thương Tin District, Hanoi

The Thuy Ung Horn Comb Craft Village, nestled in Hoa Binh Commune, Thường Tín District, Hanoi, resides near Provincial Road 427, merely 3 kilometers from the heart of Thường Tín District. The name Thuy Ung first graced in 1701, during the reign of Le Hy Tong, under the Chinh Hoa era. This village has long been celebrated for its craft of horn comb-making, expertly fashioning combs from buffalo and cattle horns. Today, the artisans of Thuy Ung not only produce distinctive horn combs but also create a myriad of exquisite horn-based artistic products. These products, characterized by their quality and stunning designs, both preserve tradition and cater to customer tastes. The range includes jewelry, household items, home decor, and massage tools, serving the domestic market and finding appreciation worldwide. Across centuries, the craft of horn comb-making in Thuy Ung Village continues to be passed down and flourish from generation to generation.

VAN ĐIỂM


Premium Woodcraft Village

Address: Van Điểm Commune, Thường Tín District, Hanoi

Van Diem Commune is located in the southeast of Thường Tín District, within the boundaries of Hanoi. The commune boasts a railway station, Do Xa, traversed by National Highway 1A and Provincial Road 429. Notably, it's well-connected through the Phap Van – Cau Gie Expressway, with the Van Diem interchange, making it exceptionally convenient for economic, cultural, and social development. A standout industry here is the production of high-end woodcraft. The village of Van Diem stands as the largest within the commune and occupies a central position. It's an ancient village with a history dating back to the era of the Hung Kings, brimming with rich historical traditions. The traditional craft of premium woodcraft in Van Diem has endured for centuries, to the extent that residents can't recall a time when it wasn't part of the village's identity. Despite the nation's many ebbs and flows, the village's people continue to proudly preserve and promote the values of the cherished craft from generation to generation.


1. Incient Village

DUÖNG LÂM

Adress: Duong Lam Commune, Son Tay Town, Hanoi

Located just 4 kilometers from Son Tây Town, Đường Lâm comprises nine villages: Mông Phu, Đông Sàng, Đoài Giáp, Cam Thinh, Cam Lâm, Phụ Khang, Hà Tân, Hưng Thịnh, and Văn Miếu. With a history spanning over 1,200 years, Đường Lâm is a piece of "sacred land that nurtures talents," Has given birth to many heroes such as King Ngô Quyền, Great Lord Bố Cái Phùng Hưng, and the intrepid explorer Giang Văn Minh. This ancient village exemplifies traditional Vietnamese villages, preserving numerous communal houses, pagodas, temples, shrines, family chapels, and hundreds of traditional houses, representing the local architecture of the Red River Delta region. Many of these ancient houses remain well-preserved in villages like Mông Phụ, Cam Thịnh, Đoài Giáp, and Phụ Khang, showcasing traditional architectural features, constructed from wood. laterite stones, and tile roofs, with both interior and exterior designs in their original forms. Đường Lâm is also renowned for its local specialties, such as Mía chickens, Đường Lâm sugarcane, lotus feasts, Rí rice, Sọc rice, Sòi rice, soy sauce production, rice flour candy, and traditional roasted pork with crispy skin.

Address: Ha Mỗ Commune. Đan Phương District. Hanoi


Hạ Mỗ, situated in the district of Đan Phượng, is a typical district in the construction of the new rural area of Hanoi. The elders of Hạ Mỗ's ancient village hold the folk verses dear to their hearts: "Our village, an ancient regal domain, Our people, the former monarch's faithful subjects... This land, once the ancient capital, The people here, loyal through ages." With these words of pride, they welcome travelers from afar, offering a unique and meaningful journey. Spending a leisurely weekend exploring Hạ Mỗ is highly rewarding, as it is rare to find a riverside ancient village with seven historical relics, each bearing the imprints and traces of history. Walking along the spacious, clean, and breezy roads, you'll experience a truly distinctive and captivating "village tour" that is second to none.


"Our Village, A Land of Former Kings..."



Address: Phù Đổng Commune. Gia Lâm District. Hanoi

Phù Đổng Commune is located in the northern part of Gia Lâm District in Hanoi. Phù Đổng is traversed by the Đuống River, which stretches for 6 kilometers, connecting it to the Red River. It boasts significant transportation routes such as National Highway 1B, Provincial Road 179, and various infrastructure networks linking to southern Đuống River regions. These favorable conditions facilitate economic development, trade, and agricultural exchange. Phù Đổng is renowned for its special national monument, the Phủ Đồng Temple, covering a total area of 60,343.7 square meters, as well as other alluring destinations. In 2021, the Hanoi People's Committee officially recognized Phù Đổng as a tourist destination





Address: Dương Xá Commune, Gia Lâm District, Hanoi

Dương Xá, with a land area of 494.68 hectares, is situated in the southeast of Gia Lâm District, Hanoi. This region is rich in historical, cultural, and revolutionary traditions. Within the commune, there are 17 historical sites (including 6 communal temples, 2 shrines, 5 pagodas, 2 communal houses. 1 ancestral house, and 1 resistance war historical site). Of these, 14 have been classified as historical sites (5 at the national level and 9 at the city level). Notably, the Bà Tấm Temple -Pagoda Complex, spanning 5 hectares, stands out. This complex venerates Y Lan - the Empress Dowager, who played a vital role in assisting King Lý Thánh Tông and Lý Nhân Tông in their battles and governance. Within this complex, you'll find the 9.1-meter-tall, 30-ton solid bronze statue of Y Lan Empress Dowager, setting a national record for the largest bronze statue. In 2020, the twin stone lions dating back to the 12th century and the Mac Dynasty's stone stelae, embellished with gold plating, at this historical site were recognized as national treasures.

5. Tolk Your Sestination DAI ANG

Address: Đại Áng Commune, Thanh Trì District, Hanoi

Đại Áng became one of the first communes in Hanoi to achieve the standards of the New Countryside Program in 2013. The local residents of Đại Áng were elated and celebrated this recognition, making it an appealing tourist destination in Thanh Trì District. The tourist attractions in Đại Áng include Đại Áng Communal House, Thiên Phúc Pagoda, the Nguyệt Áng Village's Scholarly Culture area, Nguyệt Áng Communal House, Vĩnh Thịnh Communal House, Thanh Dương Pagoda, Hoành Sơn Temple, Linh Linh Temple, Ứng Linh Pagoda, Vĩnh Trung Communal House. Among these, 9 sites have been classified as national historical monuments, and one is recognized at the city level. This spiritual and experiential tourism circuit draws visitors to explore and learn about the rich cultural history of the region. In your journey to discover Đại Áng, you'll have the opportunity to visit the traditional conical hat-making village of Vĩnh Thịnh, which has a history spanning centuries. Through the collective efforts of the local residents and the active participation of government authorities at all levels, Vĩnh Thịnh's conical hat-making industry has preserved its distinct characteristics and embodies the cultural and historical values of the ancient Kinh Kỳ land.



Reconnect with nature, the lush green meadows, and the refreshing streams await your exploration, offering a chance to unwind amidst the vast expanse, embracing the peace and serenity. Eco-tourism experiences provide a multitude of exciting activities such as lakeside camping, boat rides, waterfall treks, and outdoor adventures, immersing you in the natural world, ensuring you savor unforgettable moments with family and friends.



Address: Vân Hòa Commune. Ba Vì District. Hanoi

Ba Vi Countryside Farm is just 49 kilometers away from Hanoi's city center, nestled on a charming hillside, leaning against the Ba Vi mountain range. As you look down from the farm, you can behold the terraced paddy fields, and beyond that, the lush, verdant expanse of the pristine forests of Ba Vi, featuring three peaks at elevations of 1,100, 1,200, and 1,300 meters.

Visiting Ba Vi Countryside Farm offers more than relaxation; it allows you to explore livestock farms, poultry, and longstanding traditional agricultural villages. This picturesque landscape includes forests, lakes, ponds, streams, and rivers. You can also actively participate in a variety of agricultural tourism activities, deeply rooted in the cultural heritage of Vietnamese countryside life. These activities rely on nature's bounty, such as planting rice, transplanting rice seedlings, catching fish using bamboo tools, cultivating and harvesting wild vegetables and herbs, witnessing the process of harvesting honey, self-picking and sun-drying tea leaves, and engaging with ostriches, goats, rabbits, dairy cows, and more. Additionally, the farm organizes cultural exchange events, including singing and dancing performances with the local ethnic minority groups from the nearby Mường and Dao villages.


2. Ecotourism Destination

DAN PHƯỢNG The Phoenix Garden

Address: Đan Phượng Commune, Đan Phượng District, Hanoi

Dan Phuong Ecological Are, also known as aThe Phoenix Garden, is conveniently located close to Hanoi's city centre compared to other ecological areas. This is why many Hanoi residents are well-acquainted with the vast, refreshing space featuring terraced fields adorned with golden and white mustard flowers in full bloom. Here, you can organise picnics, go camping, hold class reunions or group gatherings while relishing the sight of pine forests, fluttering butterflies, and providing a place for children to play and relax.

Within the Dan Phuong Ecological Area, there is a beautiful and serene temple called Linh An Temple. With just half a day off, you can plan a romantic rendezvous, leisurely strolls, sightseeing, and capture cherished memories beside lush trees and vibrant blooms in this enchanting place.





3. Ecotowism Destination

HOÀNG LONG RESORT

Address: Thạch Xá Commune, Thach Thất District. Hanoi

Hoàng Long Ecotourism Resort is a remarkable tourist destination located approximately 25km west of Hanoi, along the Chua Tay Phuong Road in Thach Xa, Thach That, Hanoi. Boasting a prime location close to the city center, it is just 700 meters away from Tay Phuong Pagoda and 3km from Thay Pagoda. The resort is nestled with famous craft villages such as Chàng Sơn Carpentry Village, Paper Fan Village, and Firefly Village, all of which are part of the idyllic cultural heritage of this enchanting region.

4. Cotourism destination LÒNG HÔ VILLAGE

Address: Kim Son Commune Son Tav Town, Hanoi

For a long time, Lòng Hồ Village, located in Kim Son Commune, Son Tay Town, Hanoi, has been a favored tourist spot for both local and national visitors. Blessed by nature with beautiful landscapes, vast natural landscapes, and its proximity to Dong Mo Lake, offering a pristine environment. Visitors coming here will experience a variety of fascinating sightseeing and rural relaxation services. Presently, some of the local businesses are still somewhat spontaneous and lack a systematic approach, not fully harnessing the inherent potential. Therefore, the establishment of the Lòng Hồ Village Tourist Destination aligns with the goal of creating a collaborative development chain, aiming for a highly effective outcome. This place offers a variety of resorts and practical experiences, ranging from visiting tea hills, fruit orchards, lotus ponds, lakeside camping, to unique and convenient accommodation areas. Local households in the village also contribute to the diversity of agritourism, such as beekeeping for honey, pearl farming, specialized traditional medicine production with herbal plants, homestay businesses, creating a unique chain of travel experiences

Address: Phù Dưc 2, Phù Đổng Commune, Gia Lâm District, Hanoi


Phù Đổng Green Park, with a spacious area of 15 hectares in Phù Đổng, Gia Lâm, Hanoi, is located just about 20km from the city center, making it easily accessible within approximately 40 minutes. Upon arrival, visitors can experience the refreshing and pristine nature, participating in various entertainment activities such as camping, picnic, BBQ grilling, and playing with animals.

Phù Đổng Green Park is pioneering the development of an eco-friendly tourism-education model, where families and school classes can combine entertainment, learning, and fun activities with games like inflatable houses, sand play, carousel, slides, bumper cars, and more. Children will particularly enjoy exploring the petting zoo with friendly animals such as sheep, deer, ostriches, allowing them to learn about and feed these creatures firsthand



The Ao Vua Ecotourism Destination stretches at the foothills of the mythical Tan Viên Mountains. Here, you will immerse yourself in the vast cultural heritage and legends of Vietnam. The stories of King Hùng Duệ, Princess Ngọc Hoa, the Mountain God Sơn Tinh, and the Water God Thủy Tinh, all participating in the epic battle, have been the most beautiful legends among the Vietnamese. Visiting Ao Vua offers a fascinating and enjoyable experience with its majestic and picturesque landscapes, pristine ecological environment, and a profound human touch.

When visiting Ao Vua tourist area, besides admiring beautiful landscapes, tourists can also experience many exciting recreational activities: taking 'check-in' photos with the picturesque scenery, exploring the water park with winding slides, interesting tubes, playing with dinosaur models, flying saucers, space gyroscopes, grass sliding, swan boats on the lake, flying discs, high-speed roller coasters, bi-directional flying carpets, queen's swing, high-altitude walking challenges, and more.

Ao Vua tourist area is also chosen by many organizations as a venue for team-building activities or weekend relaxation. Visitors can enjoy herbal baths and steam baths, and indulge in local specialties such as Ba Vi milk cake, Phu Nhi cinnamon cake, and traditional desserts like lam tea.



TẨN ĐÀ Mineral Spring

Address: Hoà Trung Hamlet, Vân Hoà Commune, Ba Vì District, Hanoi

Just over an hour's drive from Hanoi, nestled amid the cluster of tourist destinations in Ba Vì, Hanoi, lies a well-known travel spot celebrated for its ancient Vietnamese cultural ambiance and its spa services, offering mineral hot springs that flow from the Holy Tån Viên Mountain. It's known as the unique Tån Đà Spa Resort. This ecotourism area is designed in an open, peaceful, and harmonious manner, featuring the Old Village Clusters, which are hundreds of years old, and Lac Việt Village with its thatched-roof bungalow houses. This place preserves centuries-old traditional houses, affectionately named based on a rustic style, such as the Master's Houses, the Landlord's Houses, and the Scholar's Houses, each complete with a main house, horizontal house, and gardens, exuding a warm and inviting countryside charm.


THIÊN SƠN SUỐI NGÀ

Located at the foot of Ba Vì Mountain, Thiên Sơn - Suối Ngà Ecotourism Area offers a spectacular natural landscape of lush mountains, streams, lakes, and waterfalls, creating an enticing tourist destination, especially during the summer days. Thiên Sơn - Suối Ngà boasts picturesque mountainous terrain, meandering waterfalls, and has undergone sustainable development, elevating itself to a nationally and regionally recognized destination in Southeast Asia.
